Workplace Trends: How COVID-19 is Shaping the Future of Work

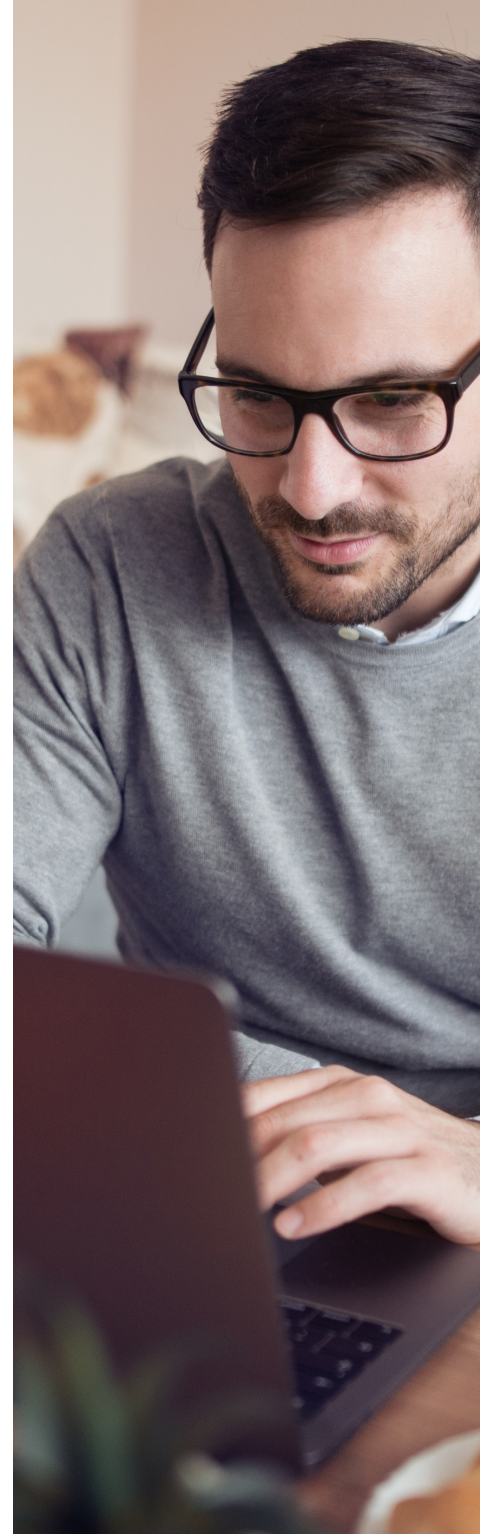
Study Methodology
